Due to the volunteer nature of our programs, it is necessary to limit individually named scholarship offerings to a minimum \$1000 value.

WCA Scholarships are awarded to women and men who will positively impact the future of corporate aviation.

Applicants must be WCA members, with dues paid in the last year. Annual membership dues are \$40 for individuals and \$25 for students.

Applications must include the following items:

1) Essay: Each application must include an essay.

Some scholarships have a specific essay length requirement. The essay should describe how the scholarship would help the applicant further his or her career goals in corporate aviation. The essay should be 500 words or less.

2) Two letters of recommendation:

The recommender must know the applicant for more than one year.

3) Certificates, transcripts, and resumes, as applicable.
