

2014 LAWRENCE GINOCCHIO AVIATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The National Business Aviation Association (NBAA) and the family and friends of Lawrence Ginocchio annually award \$4,500 to each of five undergraduate students who are officially enrolled at NBAA/University Aviation Association (UAA)-member institutions.

The Lawrence Ginocchio Aviation Scholarship was created in 2001 by NBAA and the family and friends of the late Lawrence Ginocchio to honor his outstanding personal contribution to the business aviation community. Named for a remarkable man whose strength of character inspired a high standard of caring in the aviation community, this scholarship recognizes those individuals who have demonstrated honesty, integrity and selflessness in their dealings with others. These individuals should possess a passion for aviation, as Larry Ginocchio did, and have utilized their interest or involvement in business aviation to enhance the lives of others.

Awards will be made to U.S. citizens without regard to sex, race, religion or national origin. Scholarships will be awarded in the fall of 2014 and checks will be made payable to the school. Scholarship recipients must use the funds by Dec. 31, 2015, or risk forfeit of the award.

The Ginocchio Aviation Scholarship is one of several scholarships offered by NBAA to promote professional development and business aviation careers. For all NBAA scholarships, applicants are limited to receiving one award per person, per year. For more information, visit www.nbaa.org/scholarships.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
2. Applicant must be a full-time undergraduate student (sophomore or higher) in an aviation-related two-year or four-year degree program at an NBAA/UAA-member institution (see list provided). Contact your department head or advisor for your institution's NBAA/UAA membership numbers; this application is not complete if these numbers are missing. Proof of enrollment must be provided prior to award distribution.
3. Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.
4. Fill out this application form in its entirety and sign it.
5. Submit a 500- to 1,000-word, typed, double-spaced essay describing your interest in and goals for a career in the business aviation industry and demonstrating your strength of character. Your typed name must appear at the top of the page.
6. Submit an official transcript issued by the school, or a copy of the transcript.
7. Submit a current one-page resume with permanent home address.
8. Submit two letters of recommendation, including one from a member of the aviation department faculty at the institution where you are currently enrolled. A letter of recommendation from an NBAA Member Company

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Representative is encouraged, but not required. In the letters, emphasis should be given to your outside interests, strength of character and volunteer activities.

9. Completed application package, which includes this form, one essay, one transcript, one resume and two letters of recommendation, must be received by NBAA no later than **July 31, 2014**, to be considered for the scholarship.
