Eligibility:

- Enrolled at UCF, USF, UF, FIT, ERAU, Rollins, Stetson, Florida Southern, Eckerd, or Seminole State
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.2 for Undergraduates and non-probationary standing for Graduates

Requirements:

- Typed, 500-word-maximum, scholarly essay stating an environmental challenge in the State of Florida and ways to resolve or manage, supported by references (references not included in word count)
- Typed, 100-word-maximum biography, including career goals relating to environmental stewardship
- Official transcript reflecting current academic year standing
- Must attend a METRA general meeting between April – June 2018 to present essay and receive funds
