- Be in good judicial standing with the University
- Must be available for AIR Team meetings

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Skills of a Successful AIR Team Member

- Have proficient communication skills in order to intervene and present information as needed
- Be comfortable with discussing issues connected to Title IX with students, faculty, and staff
- Demonstrate passion for bystander intervention and making Embry-Riddle a safe campus free of sexual assault
- Display professionalism when presenting information

Requirements

As a member of the AIR Team, you will be required to attend these AIR Team events:

- AIR Team Training and Retreat, early in Fall semester
- AIR Week, Spring semester
- Periodical training sessions for students, faculty and staff

The AIR Team selection process includes:

1. Completed application
2. One Recommendation Letter completed by ERAU Faculty/staff, or a former supervisor, advisor, or teacher from outside the University
3. Select candidates will be invited back for an interview with the AIR Team member and Dr. Silverman
4. Final notification
