What else should I know?

1. Safety is our number one priority.
2. **Confidential reports** can be made to a certified counselor, medical provider, or chaplain in their capacity of these positions. All other personnel would be asked to keep information private, but would be required by law to report that information to the Director of Title IX Compliance.
3. There is no statute of limitations to reporting these violations.
4. Retaliation will not be tolerated.
