CRITERIA FOR READMISSION

Any student suspended from the University must file for readmission through the Office of Records and Registration on the campus from which they were suspended by completing a readmission package. Once completed, the documents will be forwarded to the appropriate authority for review. The student will be notified of the approval or denial of their application for readmission. Students must be in good financial standing and international students must comply with current regulations and provide ERAU with an updated scholarship award letter or an Affidavit of Financial Support.

Any student suspended for poor academics may petition to return to the campus:

- 1. After 12 calendar months have elapsed following the date of suspension AND
- 2. After **Completing** a minimum of fifteen (15) semester hours of pre-approved courses from an institution with accreditation acceptable to ERAU with a CGPA of 2.5 or higher.

The following documentation must be submitted no later than 90 days prior to the start of the semester you plan to attend:

Please contact the Office of Records and Registration for specific deadline dates.

- 1. A completed application for Readmission after Academic Suspension form.
- 2. A petition, two (2) pages maximum, preferably typed stating academic and career goals, and activities in which the student has been involved, such as education, community services, and/or employment, during the absence from the University.
- 3. A copy of the Pre-Approved Courses for Readmission form.
- 4. A <u>final</u>, official transcript sent directly to ERAU from each institution of higher education that you have attended since you left. (All courses must be completed, not in-progress)
- 5. A completed Employment information form.
- 6. International students must comply with current regulations and provide ERAU with an updated scholarship award letter or an Affidavit of Financial Support.
- A copy of the Bursar's clearance form.
- 8. A non-refundable application fee.

This readmission package will be reviewed by the Campus's Readmission Committee which is part of the Academic Standards and Admissions Committee. This committee will render its approval or denial thirty days prior to the start of the student's proposed returning term. The notification letter will be attached in an email to the student's email address identified on the Application for Readmission after Academic Suspension form.
