The Women's Transportation Seminar (WTS) created this scholarship to encourage women to pursue career paths in transportation. The scholarship is awarded to women pursuing graduate studies in transportation or a related field.

The minimum criteria for the graduate scholarship selection are as follows:

- a. Open to women
- b. GPA of 3.0 or higher
- c. Currently enrolled in a transportation-related graduate degree program, such as transportation engineering, construction management, planning, finance or logistics
- d. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field
- e. Applicant must be in active student status in the Fall 2021 semester

The scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation study goals, academic records and transportation-related activities or job skills. Minority candidates are encouraged to apply.
