FLORIDA STUDENT RESIDENCY CERTIFICATION - INDEPENDENT

Who Is a Florida Resident?

For the purpose of determining eligibility for state financial assistance programs, a Florida resident is a person who has established and maintained legal residence in Florida for at least twelve months for “other than educational purposes” prior to their first semester. Residence in Florida must be for the purpose of establishing a permanent home and not merely incidental to enrollment at an institution of higher education. Generally, students who were considered to be non-Florida residents at the time they applied for admission to Embry-Riddle shall remain so classified for the duration of their enrollment. Florida law allows for limited exceptions to this rule.
