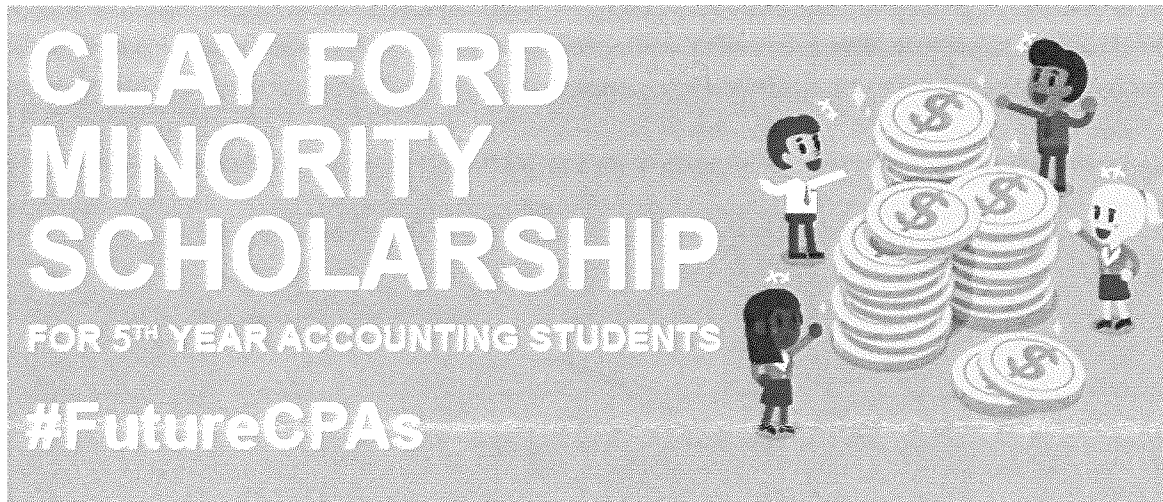

To encourage students to remain in school for the fifth year required to obtain a CPA license, a fifth-year minority scholarship program has been established; setting aside **\$200,000** per year in scholarships. If the requirements are met, and money is available, applicants may be eligible for scholarships from **\$3,000** to **\$6,000** per semester; which are awarded for a maximum of two semesters.

### **Eligibility**

- Financial need
- Ethnicity, gender or racial minority status pursuant to section s. 288.703(4), F.S.
- Scholastic ability and performance
- Completion of 120 semester hours from an accredited institution as defined by 61H1-27.001
- Florida Resident
