2025-2026 STANDARD VERIFICATION-V1 Parent Verification

Your dependent student’s 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. These documents must be translated to English, and list currency conversion to U.S. Dollars as of the date you filed the FAFSA.

3 – I did not file a tax return. Please complete the NONFILERS section below.

NONFILERS — Complete this section for anyone who will not file and is not required to file a 2023 income tax return with the IRS. You **must** submit all W-2s. If a W-2 is missing, request a replacement document from your employer or the IRS; if this is not possible, provide a signed statement that includes the amount of income earned from work, the source of that income, and the reason why the W-2 is not available in a timely manner.

If more space is needed, attach a separate page with the student’s name and ERAU Student ID number at the top. If there was no employment and no income was received, please write "none" under Employer’s Name.
