## **Fresh Start Program**

The U.S. Department of Education announced an initiative called "Fresh Start\*" for borrowers who defaulted on their federal student loans prior to the COVID-19 payment pause on March 13, 2020. If your loans are eligible, you will temporarily regain several student aid benefits (i.e., federal loans and grants if eligible). \*This is not loan forgiveness, meaning your loan debt balance is not being reduced or cancelled. All Fresh Start initiative participants must repay their loans and will have one year after the end of the COVID-19 student loan payment pause to make payment arrangements.
